A) MOTOR TREASURE HUNT



B) COMMUNITY LIBRARY

PPKI firmly believes that reading has a positive impact on individuals' focus, memory, empathy, and communication skills. In partnership with Pusat Jagaan Sinaran Impian (PJSI), we are actively working towards establishing a community library using Librarika, an integrated library system. This initiative aims to provide children and students in our Balakong community with the opportunity to borrow books for their reading pleasure – free of charge.

We will be offering free library membership to children and students aged 5-18. Currently, we have approximately 2000 storybooks and we kindly request donations of Malay storybooks suitable for children of all ages. We plan to launch the community library by January 2024 fostering a love for reading and facilitating the development of young minds.

C) BENGKEL SPM 2022/2023 & TUITION FEE SPONSORSHIP



PPKI conducts a fully sponsored SPM workshop called 'Bengkel SPM' for B40 students at PTSI SPM students annually.

The 2023 SPM Bengkel began in May, offering additional tutoring for students weak in Mathematics. For other subjects, the workshop started on July 8, 2023 and will run until January 28, 2024. Currently, PPKI sponsors ten (10) B40 students from PTSI and appeals for donations to help more underprivileged students. The feedback received from attendees has been very positive and we strongly believe that there was a significant impact on their exam results.

D) STEM PROGRAMME - INTRODUCTION TO PHTHON

We are thrilled to announce the successful completion of our 2-month Python coding program aimed at promoting programming among B40 students!

From October 8th to November 19th, 2023, PPKI proudly sponsored this initiative, providing an enriching learning experience for 62 talented PTSI students. A big shoutout to Dr. Sai Chong Yeh from Ever Al Holdings Sdn. Bhd. for spearheading this incredible journey!







E) SIGNING OF A MEMORADUM WITH PUSAT JAGAAN SINARAN IMPIAN

PPK I is delighted to announce the formalization of a Memorandum of Understanding with Pusat Jagaan Sinaran Impian. This partnership marks a collaborative endeavor to oversee the operations of the PPKI Learning Club, which currently caters to 44 children facing difficulties in reading. Noteworthy is the fact that 20 of these children receive sponsorship from both PPKI and a School for Stateless children.

The Learning Club, in addition to addressing reading challenges, focuses on enhancing skills in English, Science, and Mathematics. Currently, 6 stateless children attend classes from Monday to Friday, spanning 8:30 am to 10:30 am, where they receive comprehensive education in these critical subjects.

Additional resources are essential to further develop these educational efforts. Increased funding will empower PPKI to extend sponsorship to more stateless children, enabling them to access a well-rounded education that includes proficiency in English, Science, and Mathematics. This initiative underscores our commitment to making a meaningful impact on the lives of these children by addressing their challenges and equipping them with essential skills for a brighter future.

2. ON-GOING PROGRAMMES

A) Bumblebee (in collaboration with Malaysian CARE & Pusat Tuisyen Sinaran Impian)

Bumblebee has swiftly become a steady fixture in the Balakong community which not only provides meaningful opportunities for B40 children to learn and play but also provides attending parents with useful information provided in easy-to-understand talks by subject matter experts. Continuing with the spirit of knowledge-sharing and engagement, Ms. Rina Omar conducted another session in June, focusing on waste management and waste separation through hands-on activities as part of Bumblebee's well-structured program; other sessions took place between July and November. PPKI hopes to have the pleasure of welcoming more dedicated volunteers like Ms. Rina and Ms. Neela to support the facilitation of these Bumblebee sessions as the parents seem to benefit as much as the children.

PPKI expresses its heartfelt appreciation to Nestle Malaysia for their generous contribution of "goodie bags" containing Nestum, Honey Stars Cereals, Koko Crunch Cereals, Milo Cereals, Milo Nuggets, and Milo drinks. These delightful goodies have been provided for all Bumblebee sessions held since May 2023 and we hope that Nestle Malaysia will be able to continue this much-appreciated support.

Furthermore, PPKI extends its gratitude to Y.B. Tuan Mazwan Bin Johar, a distinguished member of the State Assembly for N26 Sungai Ramal, who graciously participated in our Bumblebee Program on 21st May 2023. On that memorable day, Ms. Rina Omar from Free Tree Society Kuala Lumpur also joined us, conducting an engaging session on gardening and sustainable living, involving hands-on activities. The next two Bumblebee sessions are planned for 17th December and 21st January 2024, why don't you drop by and experience the fun for yourself?













B) Bumblebee SPARK (in collaboration with Pusat Tuisyen Sinaran Impian)

In a heartwarming event on May 3, 2023, PPKI successfully organized the inaugural BumblebeeSPARK (Special, Precious, Acceptable, and Relatable Kids) Program, exclusively designed for children with Down Syndrome and Autism. Nestle Malaysia generously sponsored the refreshments for this special occasion whereas MR D.I.Y donated the toys, creating a delightful experience for all.

The students enthusiastically participated in engaging activities such as sand art and toy play, bringing joy to their hearts for 1.5 hours. Moving forward, starting from January 2024, PPKI has planned to conduct this meaningful program monthly, aiming to connect with parents of Down Syndrome children within the Balakong community. We extend our heartfelt appreciation to Nestle Malaysia for their invaluable support in providing refreshments for this program, contributing to its success and impact.









C) Financial Literacy and Consumer Awareness Programme







On May 28, 2023, a group of 42 students from PTSI participated in Lotus's Smart Program at The Mines Shopping Mall in Seri Kembangan, Selangor. The focus of the program was to educate the students on becoming "Smart Shoppers" by utilizing the sales and discounts available through the Lotus's App.

The students received guidance on how to assess product quality, particularly for fresh produce, and were taught to make informed choices for their daily consumption, emphasizing the importance of selecting healthy products.

During the program, the students were taken on a tour, learning how to compare prices and shop conveniently by scanning the app. PPKI graciously sponsored the insurance and bus transportation costs for all the participating students, while Lotus's generously provided goodie bags for each child in attendance.

D) Learning Club

The establishment of The Learning Club in collaboration with Pusat Jagaan Sinaran Impian aimed to assist B40 students who face difficulties with their reading and writing abilities. The implementation of phonics has resulted in a remarkable improvement in their performance. So far, 50 students have benefited from this program, making significant progress in their reading skills within a short period. PPKI is currently sponsoring the fees of 20 students.

PPKI's objective is to extend this opportunity to 120 children (across 3 sessions) every month until all the children in the community achieve the ability to read.







PPKI intends to sustain and expand the aforementioned activities throughout 2024 and beyond.
